

Successfully Scouting for Food

All scouts should participate in Scouting for Food! It is probably our best known and most successful Service Project. Encourage everyone in your unit to take part.

1. **Pick a neighborhood.**

Reserve it at the Round Table Meeting in Dec. or Jan.
Or stop by the Scout Shop and mark it on the map.

2. **Pick up bags** *from the Scout Shop.*

Enough to cover the area you sign up for.

3. **Make up Flyers**

The bags won't have any information on them so be sure you put flyers with the necessary information in each bag.

Be sure to give a day and time for pickup.

4. **Bag Dropoff**

On Saturday, January 26, put bags with the flyers inserted on all the doorknobs in the neighborhood you selected.

Do not leave them on mailboxes.

5. **Make Signs**

Post them in the neighborhood 2-3 days prior to food pick up.

They should remind residents that you are picking up the filled bags on Saturday, February 2nd. Be sure to give the pickup time.

6. **Pickup Food**

Pick up bags of food the morning of Feb. 2nd at the designated time.

7. **Bring Food to Second Harvest**

The address is **4446 Entrepot Blvd.**

Food must be there by between 11 am and 2 pm.

If you can't make these times you can drop food off on Monday between 8 am and 5 pm.

Directions: Go south on Monroe Street to Capital Circle. Turn right. Go just past the light at Spring Hill Road. Turn right on Entrepot Blvd. The building is on the left.
