- 2) Come into the Scout office now and circle the neighborhood on the map in which you wish to "scout for food"
- 3) Come into the Scout office on Weds, Jan. 19th or Weds, Jan. 26th from 2:00 pm. till 5:00 pm. to pick up your door hangers and receive a yummy treat!

Details: Scouting For Food is the council's annual service project to help feed those that are hungry. It is a way for cub scouts, scouts, and venturers to "do a good turn" for their community. Scouts will distribute door hangers which can serve as a flyer, explaining the top foods needed and when the scouts will return for the food. The resident can leave food in a recycled bag or box. "A scout is thrifty"

We are setting our goal this year for 25,000 lbs. That is 5000 pounds more than the units brought in last year. The units with the most poundage will have the opportunity to pie scout leaders from the council. This year we will pie more than one leader!!



Tips:

- Set a goal within your own unit as to how many pounds you will collect
- Have scouts make a sign to place in the neighborhood reminding folks as to date and time to put their food out.
- Encourage scout families to bring food cans to meetings
